We write in reference to your letter referred to us by the Governance Commission for GOCCs (GCG) last May 28, 2020 on the non-submission of the CCP's Citizen's Charter and/or Certificate of Compliance.


We would like to inform your good office that upon checking our records and review of the said ARTA requirements, we have already updated our Citizen's Charter which has been uploaded in our Transparency Seal since September 2019, a few days after we received your memorandum of 13 August 2019. However, the Certificate of Compliance was inadvertently overlooked as we were then busy preparing for the 50th anniversary celebration of the CCP.

Moreover, the Certificate of Compliance was one of the documents we prepared for the PBB 2019 requirements last March 10, 2020 for submission. However, due to the Covid-19 pandemic, and the total lockdown of offices last March 15 under ECQ and later MECQ, the said document was put on hold for a while. We were able to check the said requirement only upon the lifting of the MECQ to GCQ this June 1.

Hence, in compliance with RA 11032 or the Ease of Doing Business and Efficient Government Service Delivery Act of 2018, we hereby submit the Certificate of Compliance as well as the updated Citizen's Charter Handbook specifying its internal and external services whether simple, technical or highly technical.

We hope for your kind consideration on this matter.
